Frequently Asked Questions: Charity Retail Conference 2024

Where is the conference taking place?

Harrogate Convention Centre (Entrance 1) King's Road Harrogate HG1 5LA

How do I get to Harrogate Convention Centre? Directions from the South

21 minutes from the A1. Take the M1 and A1(M) before leaving at Junction 45 (Wetherby) then take the A661 to Harrogate. Alternatively continue on the A1(M) to Junction 47 (Knaresborough) then follow signs to Harrogate.

Directions from the North

24 minutes from the A1. Take the A1(M) and exit at Junction 47 (Knaresborough) then follow signs to Harrogate.

Parking is available at Harrogate Convention Centre – HG1 2HR, <u>Jubilee Car Park</u> – HG1 1DJ and <u>Victoria Car Park</u> – HG1 5LQ. Parking charges apply.

Use HG1 2HR when using your Sat Nav.

By Rail

Harrogate is linked to all major UK cities including six daily direct LNER services between London King's Cross and Harrogate Station (2 hours 46 minutes). Harrogate Convention Centre is just a seven-minute walk from the train station.

By Air

Leeds Bradford Airport (LBA) is just 12 miles away. To get from LBA to Harrogate, take the A2 bus which takes approximately 31 minutes, runs hourly and will drop you off at Harrogate's main bus station, from there it's a five minute walk to the Convention Centre.

What is the dress code?

The dress code for the conference is smart/casual – whatever you're comfortable in.

What time does registration open?

Registration opens at 9.30am on Wednesday 26 June, along with our packed exhibition, with over 50 companies and suppliers to the sector. On Thursday 27 June, registration opens at 8.30am

How do I book a taxi?

What is the dress code for the awards evening?
